

Support Services

The board recognizes that the business operations of the school system are essential -- yet ancillary and auxiliary -- to the primary function of the school system, which is education. To fulfill this secondary but important function, it is the intention of the board to:

- Ensure the proper operation and maintenance of school buildings, vehicles, equipment, and services; to set high standards of safety; to promote the health of pupils and staff; to reflect the aspirations of the community and to support environmentally the efforts of the staff to provide good instruction.
- Encourage, through the superintendent and staff, the establishment of efficient, businesslike procedures for the management of buildings, grounds, offices, vehicles, equipment, supplies and the food program.
- Encourage the establishment of a thorough, effective, and economical maintenance program, including preventative maintenance, to ensure a useful life of school property, vehicles, buildings, and equipment.
- Encourage the adherence to generally accepted management principles and applicable laws and regulations when establishing policies and regulations in these areas.
