

## **Buildings, Grounds and Property Management**

The board recognizes that the education of children is dependent upon many factors, including a proper physical environment which is safe, clean, attractive, pleasant, and functions smoothly.

The care, custody, and safekeeping of all school district property is the general responsibility of the superintendent. It will be the superintendent's responsibility to establish such procedures and employ such means that will ensure the proper maintenance and safekeeping of school district property.

Within each individual school, the principal and district maintenance supervisor will be jointly responsible for the care and maintenance of the building, equipment and grounds, and for the supervision of the school custodial services. The building principal and district maintenance supervisor will conduct a joint assessment for maintenance employees in each building on a bi-annual basis.
