Food Services Program

In recognition of the need for nourishing, well-balanced meals, the board directs the administration to establish and maintain a school lunch and breakfast program.

The food service supervisor is authorized to participate in the National School Lunch and Breakfast program as administered through the State of Idaho.

The board will set the school lunch and breakfast prices for student and adult meals as needed. Free and reduced price meals will be offered to qualified students whose parents or guardians verify income as required by state and federal regulations.

Program evaluations shall be conducted annually by the superintendent. Reports will be submitted to the board when need dictates for the smooth running of the program. Food service staff will be evaluated by the food service supervisor in conjunction with the building principal on a bi-annual basis according to each employee's job description.
