

Student Travel

- School busses will be used for all athletic and extra-curricular events that have been scheduled under the supervision of school authorities with the exception that in limited cases, private cars may be used with the approval of the principal.
- School bus drivers will drive school busses for all school functions where such services are required unless other authorization is given.
- Only students, teachers, or chaperones will be allowed to ride the bus.
- All school bus rules must be enforced.
- It shall be the responsibility of the teacher or coach in conjunction with the bus driver to supervise and maintain school bus rules, school policies, and classroom discipline both at the activity and on the bus until the return of the students to their place of dismissal. The teacher or coach shall be in charge and the bus driver shall assist the teacher in the supervision of the students.
- Students riding any activity bus (field trip, players bus or student bus) must return on that bus. Students will be released to their parents, upon request by the parents, to the appropriate chaperone, advisor, or coach. Students to be released to someone other than their parents, must have their parents secure permission from the principal prior to leaving for the activity. Should a parent wish to transport his own child to or from an activity, they may do so by notifying the principal in advance of the activity.
- Once at an activity, students are not to leave without having obtained permission from the appropriate coach, chaperone or advisor.
