Revenue from Federal Sources

The board directs the administration to examine all federal funds and to recommend to the board participation in federal programs that will benefit the district. The superintendent shall be the authorized signature for federal programs.

The administration shall develop a cost-containment plan for each federal program or specifically funded program that the board approves. The cost-containment plan shall include the following:

- Provision for phase-out of program services and personnel in a timely and orderly manner as federal or special funds are reduced or eliminated, and /or
- Provision for continuation of essential program services and personnel with district funds in a manner that does not replace or jeopardize existing, priority programs or positions.

Expenditures for any federally or specially funded program, or for any program required by state or federal mandate or regulation, or court order, shall not exceed the amount which is provided from those sources specifically for that program, plus the regular cost per student expenditure. Any exception must have prior approval by the board.
