Traffic and Parking Procedures

Although school grounds are public property, the board has the responsibility for protecting school property and for assuring the safety of all persons on school grounds. Thus it has the authority to set up controls related to driving and parking on school property, as well as the use of school grounds and facilities by the public.

Driving and parking on district property are privileges granted by the board of trustees to persons who have reasons and are authorized to be in the buildings or on school property.

Building administrators will have the responsibility for the assignment of parking areas to staff, students and visitors to the buildings. Parking areas will be designated and maintained for handicapped persons as mandated by law.
