Native American Education Program

At least once a year tribal officials and parents of Native American children shall have the opportunity to comment on equity of participation by Native American children in the educational program of the Bruneau-Grand View Joint School District No. 365. One of the purposes of the meeting will be to have parents and tribal officials present views on the Impact Aid (Public Law 874) application, evaluation, and program plan.

The meeting between parents of Native American children, tribal officials, and the school board members will be a regular meeting of the board. Parents and tribal officials may request to be placed on the agenda of any regularly scheduled school board meeting to discuss, make recommendations, and present their view.

A summary of the Impact Aid (Public Law 874) application will be published with notice that a copy of the application will be sent to any parent of a Native American child who requests in writing to receive a copy. Recommendations or any comments will be responded to in writing.
