Student Newspapers and Other Publications

The school board directs the school administration to permit certain student publications as part of the school program. Only those publications approved by the school administration shall be given school time for composition, printing, and distribution.

The objective for such publications shall be to provide students with an academic enrichment and career interest with counterparts in the adult world.

Each publication must have an advisor assigned by the school principal. It is the advisor's responsibility to ensure that the publications meet the academic and professional standards set forth by the course-of-study, curriculum guides, and school regulations.

While school publications should reflect the editorial policy of the student writers, they are, nonetheless, an official part of the school curriculum and are subject to administration review and approval prior to publication.
