Student Personnel Policy 709

Adult Education

The board of trustees endorses outreach efforts by the administration aimed at providing community/adult education. The number and type of courses shall be approved by the superintendent. All adult/community education courses must be self-sufficient; the district will, however, provide classroom space if available.

Adults Attending Regular School Programs

Adults, twenty-one (21) years of age and over, desiring to attend regular instructional programs must have board of trustee approval. Only under unusual circumstances will approval be made. As a minimum, the applicant must pay for all instructional costs and attend classes on a seat-available basis.
